**General:** Wear a red shirt for easy group identification - hat, sunscreen, water bottle and a packed lunch are required

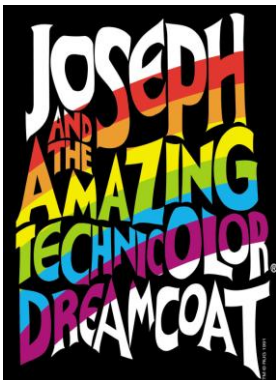
### **FRIDAY, 4<sup>TH</sup> JULY – ART WORKSHOP**
